Academic Study Modes



Coursework Mode

This mode is mainly based on attending classes, completing assignments, and passing exams, with little or no major research involved.



Research Mode

This mode focuses almost entirely on conducting independent research under a supervisor, usually resulting in a full thesis.



Study Duration

A Master's degree usually takes 1–2 years, while a PhD program typically takes 2–6 years.
